

## **APPEARANCE/DRESS CODES**

Grandview Christian School has a dress code. All students who attend the school, as well as faculty and staff, will be required to dress with cleanliness, neatness, and modesty as becomes a Christian. While a number of good things happen at Grandview Christian School, we are, first and foremost, a learning community. Everything we do should encourage learning: the appearance of both staff and students is no exception. Dress Code is intended to help avoid the attitude regarding outward appearance that has saturated our culture. We do not believe that God's requirement of His people is uniformity. We do, however, understand that appearance influences conduct and conduct influences learning, and learning is at the core of our mission.

### **BOYS - SHIRTS**

- Long or short sleeved polo shirts of any color may be worn, **no pictures or words** (Prints, plaids/flowers ok)
- Button front collar shirt may be worn, however, no **OVERSIZED** shirts will be allowed. Any color/pattern, no pictures or words

### **BOYS – SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS**

- Non- hooded color sweatshirts/sweaters, **no pictures or words**
- T shirts or collared shirt must be worn under sweatshirts / sweaters
- No hoodies, except on Wednesday and they must be GCS or State Athletic

### **BOYS – PANTS AND SHORTS**

- Pants/Shorts may be of any color (not denim), but must be **BOYS/MENS** pants/shorts. **NO SAGGING OF PANTS/SHORTS, NO SWEAT PANTS/SWEAT PANT STYLE PANTS**
- Cargo shorts or pants are acceptable

### **BOYS - SHOES**

- **All shoes must be non-marking shoes.**
- **NO ATHLETIC SLIP ON SHOES ALLOWED**
- **No house shoes** (Elementary: No open-toed or open-heeled shoes)

### **BOYS - BELTS**

- Must be worn with pants that would otherwise drop or sag below the waistline. **NO SAGGING OF PANTS.**

### **BOYS - OTHER**

- Boy's hair should be of moderate length or shorter. ( above the eyebrows, mid ears and collar)
- Facial hair is permitted; however, it cannot measure more than  $\frac{1}{4}$ " in length.
- No pierced facial areas.
- Stocking caps or any type of head covering may not be worn at school within the building. When arriving or departing with weather conditions, head gear must be removed after entering the building, or may be donned just before exiting the building. **NO HEADPHONES/EAR BUDS ALLOWED UPSTAIRS. REMOVE THEM PRIOR TO COMING UP THE STEPS.**
- No visible tattoos.
- Hair may not be dyed an abnormal color; i.e., pink, blue, green, bozo red etc. (except during spirit week).

## **GIRLS – SHIRTS**

- **Elementary Girls may wear sleeveless shirts NO SPAGHETTI STRAPS**
- Long or short sleeved polo or cotton (NOT T SHIRTS) shirts of any color/pattern may be worn. No words or pictures allowed.
- All shirts must fit properly – not too tight or too big. Shirts must not be “V” or scoop neck. NO CLEAVAGE

## **GIRLS – PANTS, CAPRIS, SHORTS**

Pants/Shorts may be of any color (not denim), leggings UNDER skirts/dresses only. **Leggings may NOT be worn as pants.**

- No pants, capris or shorts may be skin tight NO LEGGINGS/JEGGINGS
- Cargo shorts and pants are allowed
- Shorts must be knee length or below

## **GIRLS – SKORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS**

- Skorts, skirts, and jumpers must be knee length or below and leggings/ shorts must be worn under all skirts/dresses

## **GIRLS – SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS (MUST HAVE SHIRT UNDER SWEATSHIRT/SWEATER)**

- No hoodies, except on Wednesday – must be GCS or State Athlete
- Any color non-hooded sweatshirts/sweaters NO PICTURES OR WORDS
- Must have a shirt, collared or crew neck under the sweatshirts

## **GIRLS - SHOES**

- All shoes must be non-marking shoes.
- No house shoes (Elementary: No open-toed or open-heeled shoes)
- No athletic slides

## **GIRLS - OTHER**

- Stocking caps or any type of head covering may **not** be worn at school within the building. When arriving or departing in accordance with weather conditions, head gear must be removed after entering the building, or may be donned just before exiting the building. **NO HEADPHONES/EAR BUDS UPSTAIRS. REMOVE THEM BEFORE COMING UP THE STEPS.**
- All other hair accessories/coverings will be at faculty/administration discretion
- No visible tattoos.
- Hair may not be dyed an abnormal color; i.e., pink, blue, green, bozo red, etc. (except during spirit week).

**No provisions will be made to accommodate facial or body piercings while school is in session.**

**NO COATS OR JACKETS ARE ALLOWED IN CLASSES, in the hallway during school hours, in the gym at lunch.**

**GCS has jean’s day every Wednesday. For a student to be able to participate, they must pay \$1 for the jeans. Below are the guidelines for jean’s day.**

### **JEAN'S DAY POLICY**

- **No skinny or skin tight jeans for girls or boys**
- No holes in jeans
- No sagging of jeans/shorts
- Jean shorts, knee length, may be worn
- Jean capris may be worn
- Jean skirts may be worn, but must be knee length or below and leggings must be worn under them.
- No cutoffs or frayed hems

### **JEAN'S DAY SHIRTS/HOODIES**

- GCS T shirts and hoodies sold in the school office
- League or conference shirts or hoodies
- GCS sponsored meet shirts
- ALL shirts must fit appropriately
- **ALL hoods must remain down during school day**

### **Food and Drink**

Eating upstairs is prohibited, unless it is during a CLASS SPONSORED PARTY. Students may have water bottles, they must be clear bottles and they may ONLY have WATER in the bottles. By clear, we mean CLEAR, not a "see through blue, green, yellow, etc." color. It must be CLEAR.
